

SUPPLEMENT

On October 12, 2020 around 2231 hours, I heard Ofc Grommes advise over the radio that shots had been fired. I observed on unit status monitor that Ofc Grommes was on a call at 2290 Ave C. I then responded lights and siren from the area of Elysian Rd and Mallowney Ln. While en route I heard officers advise they were in the alley between Ave C and Ave B.

I arrived in the area and parked my vehicle on Ave C just north of the scene that was in the alley. I observed that medical had just arrived on scene. On a sidewalk in the alley I observed medical performing CPR on a male. Beside the male I observed what appeared to be fresh blood. Near the male to the west I observed a black handgun just off the sidewalk in front of a vehicle. I stood over the gun while the male was being worked on by medical as I was told the gun was involved. I did not touch the gun and it appeared to be a Taurus handgun unknown caliber. The male was put on a stretcher and then put on a gurney and was transported by ambulance. I observed officers placing crime scene tape around the scene.

I was advised by Sgt Hoeger to move my car from Ave C to the alley way to help preserve the crime scene. I then observed that detectives were called to the scene. I then assisted with securing the scene.

Around 0600 hours I was advised that Ofc Nelson and Ofc Bickford's vehicles were still on scene and needed to be moved back to the barn. I then drove Ofc Bickford's vehicle back to the barn. Lt Finnegan assisted me by giving me a ride back to the scene. I then drove Ofc Nelson's vehicle from the scene to the barn. I then drove Ofc Denio's vehicle from the barn to the scene as she was already on scene with the crime scene van. I then cleared from the scene.

I had no further involvement in this case.
